Lesley had been a motorsport enthusiast from her late teens when she started lap scoring at Liverpool Speedway in the 70's. When Allan joined the PCRA and returned to racing in the late 1980's Lesley picked up lap scoring again at PCRA club days. Eventually she joined the Road Race Timers established by the late Ernie Reynolds Sr and Jr, then continued by Dave Cameron, Warren Reynolds, Derek Green, Jan Blizzard OAM, Judy Dahlitz and Sue Dorling. She remained an active member until the team disbanded mid 2018 due to transponder race timing taking over.

She had a passion for Motorsport that spanned 50 years. She travelled around NSW and interstate with the timing team covering PCRA and other meetings. From lap scoring support races at the Eastern Creek Grand Prix 500cc with Doohan, to V8 Supercars at Oran Park and Super Motards at Queensland Raceway.



Les enjoyed the comradery and lifelong friendships made within the PCRA. She would attend every meeting with a smile and loved the banter of early morning scrutineering, checking everyone's leather and helmets over before the days racing. You could find her in the tower all day, and she was incredibly talented at manually recording the race numbers as they flew past the tower.

She had a great ability of recognising riders by their helmets and machines as well as their race numbers. There was always a cuppa to be had, and usually a fruitcake that she'd made to share.

Lesley passed away the 31st May 2024 after a long illness aged 70.

With the kind permission of One Raceway, some of Lesley's ashes have been spread at the newly refurbished racetrack where she spent countless hours and created many happy memories.

**ROBERT MAXWELL BLYTHE 1944 - 2024**

I was introduced to Bob by his brother Kevin who worked at BMI's Prospect Quarry. They ran a car wrecking yard in Smithfield called C & R Wreckers and when I asked Bob how the name was linked to the family, Bob replied "C & R stands for crooks and robbers, nothing to do with us". Bob was never without his sense of humour and the yard's association with Renault cars was maintained whenever he sponsored historic motorcycle racing through advertisements for his Renault Enterprises.

I had more contact with him when he set up an engineering business in Toongabbie at which he prepared the Honda CB72 (originally 250cc but expanded to nearly 500cc) and that motorcycle, along with its rider (Mr Towering Arrogance) brought him into confrontation pretty well everywhere it was raced. Bob fought the people who opposed his motorcycle until it was settled when an appeal to MA was found

in his favour. With such a highly stressed power plant the bike was remarkably quick but not quite as reliable. At Winton it had four starts and four wins but poor Bob wasn't at that meeting to bask in its glory.

When the Historic Racing Register started running motorcycle racing at Eastern Creek they pulled out after only a few years and Bob Blythe started promoting meetings which were influenced by the American Historic Racing Motorcycle Association whose rules had different age periods to ours. To help publicise these events he brought over some excellent riders from the US and I think their influence prompted Bob's next and major contribution to our sport: The Barry Sheene Festival of Speed which he promoted until the NSW PCRA took over the running in early 2000s. Bob's bringing American racers (read "Road racing Royalty") to race with us at Eastern Creek elevated those meetings to a very high status and they were a fitting tribute to Barry Sheene.

Bob will be forever one of the good guys.

There was a disappointing number of entries for Club finances – we needed about 80 to break even - we got 67.

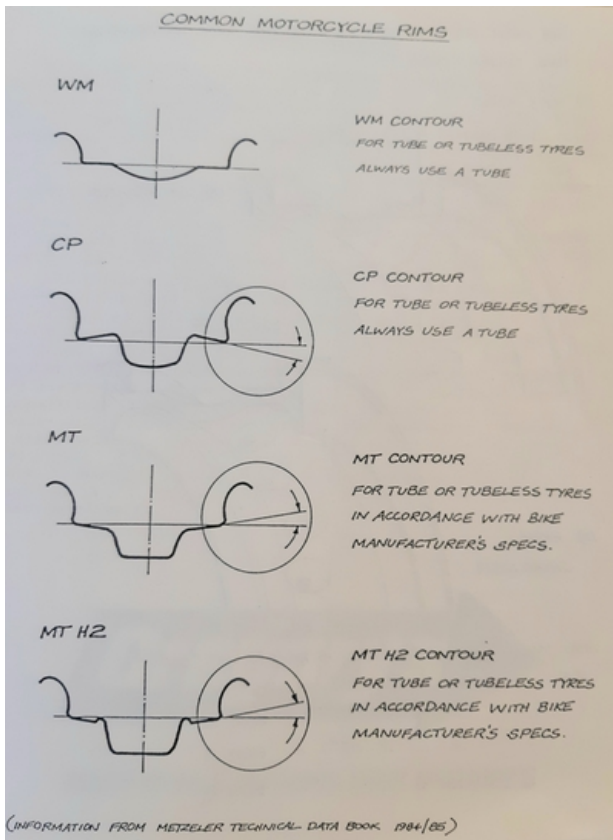

- Nearly 300 members!

- 9 local(Oran/Amaroo/Wakefield) meetings!
- Track hire in total for 1997 was reported as \$11,830!
- What HAPPENED ??

Lots of trophies remain uncollected from 1997 and threats to recycle uncollected ones in 1998.

April Issue featured TWO TZ250 Articles: David Lovell wrote 4 pages on restoring his 1976 'C' model TZ250 Yamaha in "Reminiscences of a Race Team 1983 - 1995", and:

"Mission Impossible" Attempting to win the Bol d'Or. From Sept 1993 Issue of RPM

August Issue featured a reprint of an ACMN 1986 article about buckets in New Zealand, but this is hard to believe:

*one of bucket racing's peculiarities is the somewhat casual emphasis placed on actual race results*

A **Ken Watson** gets a mention riding a Laverda SFC at Eastern Creek:

**Aussie & PCRA riders do well at Eastern Creek Historic International !**

On the Australia day long weekend, partaking in the Formula Four Stroke Meeting, part time Forgotten Era riders Mike Soderland and Simon Thomas defeated overseas and local riders as well as setting new class record, both mounted on Clatworthy / Williams Nortons.

Mike, on a ES2 in the Premier 500 race, edged out overseas rider Glen English and John Cronshawby 1/2 a second to set a new 500cc historic lap record of 1.49.23.

In the 750cc Sportsmans Challenge Frank Zappia ran 3rd on a BSA Rocket 3 to winner Vic Vassella ( Norton Dominator ) and Ken Watson ( Laverda SFC ).

Alan Murray crashed in Sunday's rain into turn 3 on the single Duke, luckily escaping with only bruises.

Greg Johnson's previous 1997 best Classic time ( of 1m 49s ) was shattered by Simon during a Battle of the Twins Race on the Norton Atlas, - 1.47.87. Simon lost this record soon to Peter Guest ( Vincent 998 Lightning ) during a BEARS Heritage race - 1.47.36 .but only till the last lap when Simon bagged the race win and reset the record with a shattering 1.46.58 !

# Amaroo Park sold for housing

A PIECE of Sydney's motor racing history is likely to disappear following the \$4 million sale of Amaroo Park. The 8ha circuit on Sydney's north-western outskirts, the scene of weekend racing broad- metres off the circuit you would hit something. "The only time I have been upside down was at Amaroo." Former racing car driver Alan Grice, now a Queensland State MP, also found the going tough at Amaroo. "There was very little to any people who were willing to retain Amaroo Park as a track, but the likelihood was that it would be sub-divided into small hobby farms or for people who liked large rural home lots. The track has maintained its popularity, attracting more than 5000

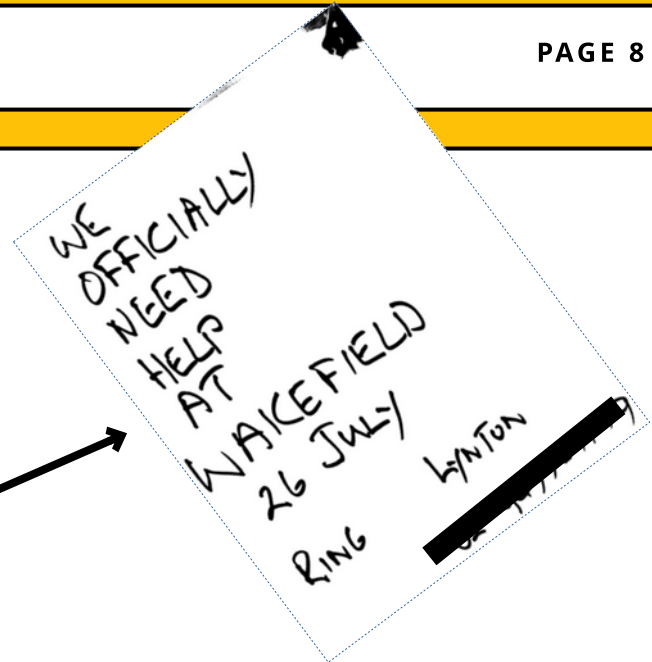
# 1998

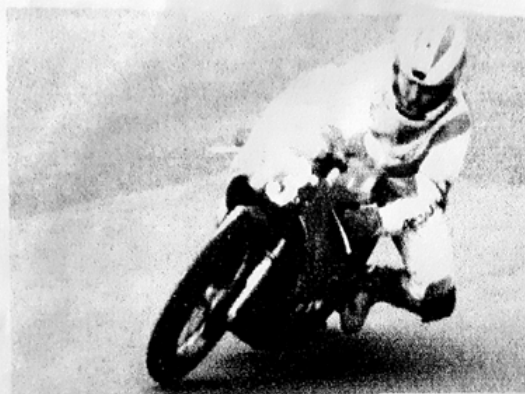
November Issue: Lots of features, letters.

Forgotten Era is debated throughout the year with a questionnaire appearing in this issue. The rules NZ adopted are very simple, see below:

The returned information will be used ( results published ) to make suggestions to M.A. to enable Rules to be written which may be clear and to the point, Hopefully this will result in enough uniformity between states to allow an Australian Championship to take place. It will also accommodate Trans Tasman Challenges with more clarity, but we must have FULL Australian agreement .

It has been pointed out to us that the Kiwis have a workable rule system.  
New Zealand rules are: 83-'82  
 Forgotten Era ( Period 82 ) machine specifications.  
 Water cooled engines and Mono shock rear suspensions unless fitted as original equipment are prohibited.  
 Wheel design may of wire spoke or alloy construction. Wheel rims unless fitted as original equipment shall be 17" minimum diameter. Maximum width shall be 3.5" front and 5.00" rear.  
 Tyres , Open.  
 Upside down forks are prohibited.  
 Fuel, Petrol only  
 That is No1. Racing fuel or Avgas sold by Shell, BP, Mobil. Two strokes may only use Acetone up to 5% as a blending agent castor type oils.  
 Classes; Up to 250cc  
           Up to 350cc  
           Up to 500cc  
           Open ( up to 1300cc)
